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## Respiratory Pathogen Panel with COVID 19 Test

## How long until I have results?

Results will be sent to your physician 24-48 hours from the day your test is performed.

## Where will my results be sent?

Your physician will be directly notified of your results either via fax or our physicians' portal. For your privacy, we can not disclose any results to anyone except your physician.

### Will this be painful?

Most people describe the test as a "slight discomfort."

### How is the specimen collected?

A swab is briefly inserted into your nasal cavity for several seconds. That's it.

#### What is the cost of the test?

We collect your insurance information upon scheduling the test. Many insurances have waived any copay or deductible associated with COVID-19 testing. We strongly encourage you to check with your insurance provider for their specific guidelines

### How long will the test take?

The check in and nasal swab will take less than a minute. You will remain in your vehicle the entire time.

## What is the process of being scheduled for a test?

We must first receive a laboratory order form from your physician. Upon receipt, we will immediately call you to schedule your test.

## What pathogens does this test detect?

We do a 28 panel test that tests for COVID-19 (SARS-CoV-2 RNA) as well as the following:

## What precautions are in place for the testing procedure?

Our medical staff are following the guidelines set in place by the CDC and are using full PPE. Patients will not leave their vehicle at any time. We ask that you keep your window rolled up until you are about to be tested.
